



# Interchange Landscape




TOTAL INTERCHANGE LANDSCAPE AREA APPROXIMATELY 8 ACRES

Most interchange landscape enhancements are focused around the bridge and the ramp intersections. Elsewhere most of the landscape is native seeded with no new trees, shrubs or irrigation.

Because of the extent of regrading for ramps on the west side of the interchange only a few of the existing trees will likely remain.


