



**Town of Superior**  
**Recycling and Conservation Advisory Committee Meeting**  
**Notes from Meeting – December 12, 2013**

1. Members of the Committee in attendance: Rachael Bray, Anne Shanahan, Corrine Lythgoe, and Dawn DeMent

2. Council Liaison Report – RCAB (Resource Conservation Advisory Board) may look into a joint Construction & Demolition diversion program IGA program for municipalities in Boulder County. More information will be provided as this project progresses.
3. Report from Education Program:  
Wise With Waste Tour – Students visit the Center for Hard-to-Recycle Materials ReSource (construction waste recycling) and the Boulder County. Transportation, staff/instructor time and materials are all funded by the Town's contribution. In spring, 2013 Superior Elementary third graders (228 total) were able to participate and in fall, 2013 Eldorado K-8 second graders (224 total) were the participants.  
In addition, the program known as Locker Leftovers was implemented at the end of the 2013 school year. This project diverts materials from trash during the Eldorado K-8's middle school locker clean-out session. Students sort their unwanted items for delivery to charity and for recycling, leaving little trash behind and clean hallways. The 487 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade students learn about waste diversion from Eco-Cycle staffers.  
The Town provides \$4800 annually toward this program with the cost per student being \$5.11.
4. Tonnage Reporting from Haulers:  
Superior hauling contract to date (January through November reporting) showed a total of 1135 tons of trash (64.2%) and 633 tons of recycling (35.8%). Staff continues to work with Rock Creek HOA Board to retrieve the collection data for that contract – more information forthcoming.
5. 2014 RCAC Work Plan. Final review of the plan with task list for Arbor Day and other plan matters.
  - a. Staff to contact: Energy Smart, Eco-Cycle, CRC, and CEC. (Arbor Day)
  - b. Can a master gardener/CSU Extension person give a tour of Asti Park garden? (Arbor Day, if possible)
  - c. Rachael Bray to reach out to Boulder Parks Contact Dave Sutherland. (Arbor Day)
  - d. Corrine to reach out to student groups; ex. NetZero at Fairview. Staff to assist. (Arbor Day)
  - e. Re: Fall Leaf Collection – get more information on what other communities do and see if scout groups have interest in taking lead on this type of program, similar to Christmas tree recycling program. (3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter)
  - f. Yard Waste – can requiring identification/proof of Superior residency be initiated?
  - g. Promote green holidays as part of the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter. Added to the Plan.
